



CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Your entry into either the Scenic Rim Ultra 105km Marathon, 65km, 35km or 25km event will confirm that you fully understand and accept these Conditions of Entry. Failure to adhere to any of these conditions may result in immediate disqualification without refund.

1. You are required to have completed at least a 50km race if you are entering into the 105km race.
2. It is your responsibility to ensure that, on race day, you are sufficiently fit and healthy to complete the Event within the official cut-off times.
3. You must be at least 18 years of age on race day to compete in the event.
4. If you are competing in the 105km event, you will be required to weigh in at the Bib Collection.
5. The Organisers reserve the right to change the official cut-off times at any stage prior to or during the event in the interest of the participants safety or for any other reason.
6. You understand that the course is technical, remote and physically demanding and that emergency medical aid may be slow to reach you. This constitutes a high risk of serious injury, or possibly death, if any emergency situation occurs while on course.
7. Before the start and during the race, you must monitor your own health and well-being and withdraw in the event that you are no longer fit enough to continue safely.
8. Before registering, you are required to read the Waiver.
9. You are responsible for the behaviour of your support crew and supporters. It is your responsibility to ensure they read and

understand the “Crew/Spectator Information”, and that they do not, knowingly or otherwise, break any rules.

Insurance

On The Edge Events carries its own public liability insurance. However, we do not provide any insurance to cover runners for accident and injury nor ambulance services. We strongly recommend that all runners carry their own insurance to cover these for personal risks.

Refunds, Transfers & Cancellation

In the unfortunate instance that you can no longer participate in the event, refunds or transfers may be possible as per below.

Participants can transfer their pre-registered entry to another person. Entries can be transferred to another person up until 1/8/2022. A transfer fee of \$40 will apply to all transfers. If you need to transfer your entry to another person, please email us at andrew@ontheedgeevents.com.au, so we can update the details.

Participants can transfer from the 105km to the 65km; the difference between the two entry fees will not be refunded. Please email us at andrew@ontheedgeevents.com.au. If participants want to transfer from 65km to the 105km course, you will be required to pay the difference on the day of the event and please notify us by emailing andrew@ontheedgeevents.com.au.

If you cannot find anyone to take your ticket, you may be available for a refund as per the below details:

- \$50 admin fee charged before 1/5/2022
- No refund after 1/5/2022

Event organizers reserve the right to alter the course without notice and/or cancel the event in consultation with, and under the direction of emergency service agencies and major event stakeholders or landowners. In the unlikely circumstance that the event is cancelled for reasons outside our control such as weather, fire, flood, park closures or any other reasons, we will attempt to provide some compensation to

entrants, however there is no guarantees as to the extent of this compensation due to the costs incurred prior to cancellation. If you are unable to compete due to medical reasons, you must provide us with a medical certificate, and a refund maybe considered but not guaranteed. No refunds will be given if you change your mind. No responsibility is assumed or taken by the organisers for lost travel or accommodation expenses, of for part or full loss of entry fees paid.

Covid 19 Policy:

If it is cancelled to due Covid, we would appreciate and hope you agree that you are happy for us to transfer your entry to the following year. Being a small family business, it would be a huge help for us to weather the financial hit that cancellation would cause, with many funds already allocated to the event. We may also attempt to provide some compensation to entrants, however there is no guarantees as to the extent of this compensation due to the costs incurred prior to cancellation.

If you are coming from interstate or international, we are happy to transfer your entry to the following year or you can transfer to another person to use the following year if you are unable to make it without incurring a transfer fee.

If you have been diagnosed with Covid-19, or experience Covid-like symptoms on or a few days prior to the event, we fully understand and appreciate you not turning up. We will transfer your entry to the following year or you can transfer your entry to another person without incurring any additional fees.
